### **3-In-1 Ranch Rodeo**

**June 5 @ 5 p.m.**

Sunday will be a 3-in-1 format with 3-man teams. Each team will have three (3) head of cattle in the arena at the same time. They will have to load one (1) in a trailer, tie one (1) down and doctor one (1). There will be no loop limit but there will be a 5-minute time limit. These tasks may be done in any order. Teams will start in a designated area. Upon the signal from the flag man, the team may proceed across the line and start the event. If the team crosses prior to the signal, a 45 second penalty will be added.

#### Trailer loading

- One (1) of the steers must be loaded into a stock trailer and the gate latched. If the steer comes out of the trailer before the team is done with the event, they will receive a NO TIME

#### Tie Down

- The team must rope one (1) steer with a legal head catch (around the horns, neck or half head) while the other teammate either catches the steer by the feet (no penalty for single leg catch) or mugs the steer to the ground.
- The team must then tie the steer by three legs, and it must remain tied for 6 seconds. If the steer does not remain tied for 6 seconds, the team may re-tie the steer (as long as they have not called for the timer to stop)

#### Doctoring

- The team must rope one (1) steer with a legal head catch (around the horns, neck or half head) while the other teammate either catches the steer by the feet (no penalty for single leg catch) or mugs the steer to the ground.

- Once down, a clear mark must be made on the steers forehead and all ropes removed.
- This event will be complete once all ropes are off the steer, the mark is made, and the steer is back on its feet.
- **Other Rodeo Rules and Info:**
- The rodeo officials have final say on calls regarding time and rule infractions. What they say is final.
- There will be no alcohol allowed in the warm-up areas or arena floor. We ask that you refrain from drinking alcohol prior to competing. This is a family friendly/ ministry event.
- All teams must attend a pre-rodeo meeting 45 minutes prior to the first team running (1:15pm). There we will answer any last-minute questions, inform teams of any changes, and ensure everyone has completed proper paperwork.
- **ALL PAPERWORK, WAIVERS, AND PAYMENTS MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO COMPETING.**
- We understand that some contestants will be on multiple teams. We will try to space your runs out, but we cannot guarantee that. Please understand that you may have to run back to back runs.
- Please be aware of your teams running order and be ready to go when it is your turn. Each team will have a 3-minute window in which they must be in the arena, ready to go. If the whole team is not there in that time frame, a NO TIME will be given for that event.
- We reserve the right to disqualify you and/ or your team for any reason that we see fit. No unsportsmanlike conduct will be tolerated. If you are disqualified, you will not receive a refund.
- Any action deemed to be abusive towards the livestock (cattle or horses) can result in a disqualification.
- Any added money will go to the team with the fastest time in a single event.
- We will have a 50% payback spread across the top 3 teams as well as prizes for each placing team. Please check back with us as we secure the exact prizes.
